

**AMENDING ORDER 18
TO THE
GENERAL ORDER AND REGULATIONS 2023
MADE BY
THE BRITISH COLUMBIA TURKEY MARKETING BOARD**

February 13, 2024

The British Columbia Turkey Marketing Board orders as follows:

This Order comes into effect on February 13, 2024.

THE BRITISH COLUMBIA TURKEY MARKETING BOARD pursuant to
THE NATURAL PRODUCTS MARKETING (BC) ACT (The Act)
And the BRITISH COLUMBIA TURKEY MARKETING SCHEME (The Scheme)

Under General Order 2023 Rental of Facilities – Page 20

From:

15. A grower who wishes to rent facilities from any person must make application to the Board for approval of the rental arrangement. The Board shall approve a rental arrangement only if it satisfies the following criteria:
- a. the application must be accompanied by a valid and legally enforceable rental agreement,
 - b. the rental agreement must be for a minimum term of four months. (The Board recommends that any rental agreement with a term greater than three years should be registered with the Land Title Office.), and
 - c. the owner of the facility must receive Board approval of the rental arrangement before placing any poults in the rented facilities.

To:

15. A grower who wishes to rent facilities from any person must make application to the Board for approval of the rental arrangement. The following criteria apply to rental arrangements:
- a. the rental agreement must be valid and legally enforceable;
 - b. the rental agreement must be for a minimum term of four months;
 - c. the rental agreement must receive Board approval before any poults are placed in the rented facilities;
 - d. the renter is to be actively engaged in the business of farm operations, keep flock records, enter into a Growers' Program, and maintain a grower's license;
 - e. the renter is to be responsible for all revenues and expenses associated with their flocks in the rented facilities. This must include poult costs, feed costs, and revenue from turkey sales; and,
 - f. the renter is to complete all on-farm audits as per the Farm Practices Regulation.
