Subject: Updated Notice of Consultation

Dear Industry Stakeholders,

On April 8, 2024, the BC Turkey Marketing Board (BCTMB) issued a Notice of Consultation on two policy and regulatory projects in 2024:

- 1. Review of the General Order & Regulations
- 2. Development of Administrative Monetary Penalties (AMP) Policies and Procedures (P&P)

At that time, the Farm Industry Review Board (FIRB) was requiring all supply-managed Commodity Boards to develop and implement AMPs as an enforcement tool option in the interests of sound marketing policy. FIRB has since issued a new directive to the Boards that makes the development of AMPs optional.

The BCTMB has reviewed this new directive and determined that it will not be proceeding with AMPs at this time. The Board has sufficient compliance and enforcement tools in place through the TFC On-Farm Programs and it's the General Orders including license suspension, license cancellation, and alternative license classes.

The General Orders review will proceed as originally planned.
