

## BC Turkey Marketing Board Updated Notice of Consultation

Subject: Updated Notice of Consultation

Dear Industry Stakeholders,

On April 8, 2024, the BC Turkey Marketing Board (BCTMB) issued a Notice of Consultation on two policy and regulatory projects in 2024:

- 1. Review of the General Order & Regulations
- 2. Development of Administrative Monetary Penalties (AMP) Policies and Procedures (P&P)

The Board then issued an updated Notice of Consultation on June 4, 2024, stating that it will not proceed with #2 (Development of Administrative Monetary Penalties Policies and Procedures) due to updated directives from the Farm Industry Review Board (FIRB).

The review of the General Order & Regulations has proceeded according to the timeline and steps outlined in the April 8, 2024 notice. Steps 1 through 4 are now complete:

The Board is now working on a draft of the new General Orders. Due to the pressures placed on the industry by Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI), this phase will take longer than originally planned. The Board now expects to have a draft new General Orders to industry for review and comment in early 2025. The new General Orders are expected to be in place before the start of the 2025/2026 quota year April 27, 2025).
