

**AMENDING ORDER #1
TO THE
GENERAL ORDERS OF APRIL 27, 2025**

**MADE BY
THE BRITISH COLUMBIA TURKEY MARKETING BOARD
ON APRIL 8, 2026**

The British Columbia Turkey Marketing Board orders as follows:

1. Section 3 of the General Orders of April 27, 2025 is amended by repealing the definition of “Quota Year” and replacing it with the following:

“Quota Year” means:

- (a) for the 2025/2026 period, the 52-week period commencing on April 27, 2025, and ending on April 25, 2026;
- (b) for the 2026/2027 transitional year, the 14-month period commencing on April 26, 2026, and ending on June 26, 2027, during which time the Board may, by resolution, proportionately adjust any allocation, licence fee, production sleeve, allowance, or other privilege or requirement set out in these General Orders to account for the extended duration of the transitional period; and,
- (c) from and after June 27, 2027, a 52 or 53-week period commencing on the Sunday following the last Saturday in June of one year, and ending with the last Saturday of June in the following year.

2. Section 13 of the General Orders of April 27, 2025 is replaced with the following:

13. Every application for a license must be made to the Board in the required form, and must be accompanied by the appropriate fee as set out in Schedule 1, by the following deadlines:
 - a) For the Quota Year ending April 25, 2026: by April 15, 2025;
 - b) For the 2026/2027 transitional year: by January 15, 2026; and,
 - c) For Quota Years commencing June 27, 2027 and thereafter: by March 15th of each year for licensing effective on the first day of the subsequent Quota Year.

3. Section 119 of the General Orders of April 27, 2025 is replaced with the following:

119. Every Grower shall prepare an annual Grower Program to be reviewed and signed by their Processor or Turkey Broker and Hatchery or Poultry Broker. The fully signed Grower Program is to be filed with the Board by the 31st day of May each year, effective for the upcoming Quota Year.

4. Section 28 of the General Orders of April 27, 2025 is replaced with the following:

28. Export Regrow Quota shall be issued to Growers according to the methodology in the Board's Export Policy.

5. This Order comes into effect on April 8, 2026.
